# ASKING - THE MISSING LINK

Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him? -Matthew 7:7-11

to make inquiry into; request; demand

to ask for with proper authority; claim as a right; charge with a commission to go in search or quest of: to try to find or discover by searching or DEMAND SEEK

questioning; try to obtain; try to attempt; explore to strike a sounding blow with the fist, knuckles, or anything hard, esp. on a KNOCK door, window, or the like, as in seeking admittance, calling attention, or giving

a signal: to knock on the door before entering

- 1. AFRAID (FEAR)
  - of REJECTION a.
  - of EXCLUSION b.
  - of ISOLATION
- 2. ARROGANCE (PRIDE)
  - I 'KNOW IT ALL' α.
  - I won't ask 'THEM' b.
  - I'll look 'STUPID'
- 3. APATHY (PASSIVE)
  - You are INDIFFERENT (I don't care)
  - You are LAZY (too much work) b.
  - You are PESSIMISTIC (It won't C. help or improve anything)

### 4. ASSURED (NO CONFIDENCE)

- of SELF
- of the PERSON you're asking **b**.
- of the ACCURACY of information C. you receive
- of your ABILITY to execute d. information received
- 5. APTITUDE (KNOWLEDGE)
  - you don't know WHAT to ask
  - you don't know WHO to ask b.
  - you don't know HOW to ask C.
  - you don't know WHEN to ask

## THE PROCESS OF ASKING

ASK (THE DEMAND) ->'MAKES THE NOISE', creates, defines, identifies, authorizes

SEEK (THE JOURNEY) ->'MOVES THE FEET', searches, discovers, reveals, removes

KNOCK (THE CONFLICT) ->'FIGHTS THE BATTLE', confronts, accesses, possesses, prevails

## THE TEXT

    - The ASSURANCE that you will 'get it'
    - ii. The AUTHORITY needed to 'get it'
- 2. SEEK AND YE SHALL FIND
  - what shall I FIND?

- KNOCK AND THE DOOR SHALL BE OPENED 3.
  - Why must I KNOCK?
    - 'It' has been your ANSWER
    - The AFFIRMATION
  - **b**. What is the DOOR?
    - The ACCESS
