6. Define the words 'SANCTIFIED', 'PRESERVED', and 'CALLED'.
7. Why did JUDE begin his salutation with 'MERCY', 'PEACE', and LOVE?
8. What is the significance of JUDE writing to "those who are sanctified", and not "to the saints"?
9. Read Jeremiah 1:4-5, and John 15:16. Based on #8, what does this reveal?
